

Boulder With Kids, Free and Cheap

More of Boulder is free with children than you'd think, and the free options come first here. Including one popular recommendation that isn't actually open to the public.

There's no public ice rink in Boulder. The only rink is at CU's Student Recreation Center and CU's own page says a Rec Center membership is required, with skating limited to students, members and their guests. Family guides list it as a Boulder activity. It's not one. There's no roller rink either.

City recreation centers	\$15 adults, \$9 youth 2 to 17, \$32 for a group of four	One pass covers all three centers the same day. Pools close for maintenance, usually August.
Museum of Boulder	\$12 adults, \$10 youth 5 to 17, under 5 free	Free with a Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) card and free for members. The Playzeum and Google Garage are the child-focused galleries.
Fiske Planetarium	\$12 adults, \$8 youth 4 to 17, plus a \$1.50 fee	Closed during Folsom Field concerts and CU home football games.
Scott Carpenter Pool	\$15 adults, \$11 youth 2 to 17, \$35 for a group of four	Outdoor summer pool, separate from the free park beside it.
ABC Kids Climbing	Paid, price not published	Youth-specific and coach-led, built for children from two and a half up.
Boulder Rock Club	Day pass, price not published	Tiny Tots is 4 to 5; the teen belay class is 12 to 17.
